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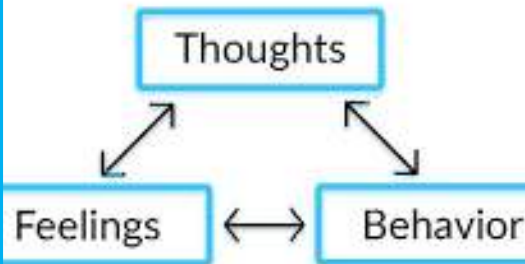
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The Cognitive Triangle



Psycho-educational Programs for Non-offending parents/guardians

The purpose of the program is to provide an overview of sexual offender ideology, education and understanding. While at the same time, fulfilling the Courts expectation of completing classes (CPS, DFS, DCFS, or Parole and Probation, etc.). In addition, this will aid with guidance and structure for safety planning and a better understanding of overall families boundaries.

There are two separate programs one which focuses on adults and the other one is created for juveniles.

ADULT NON-OFFENDING PARENTING CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

This program is designed for individuals that may have someone in the family where sexual abuse allegations exist, or a person convicted of a sex offense lives at home, to help educate the responsible parties (non-offending parents) for the safety of the children in the family and in the community. This program can also be used as an educational tool for those who have allegations of sexual abuse,

to better understand sexually abusive behaviors and to establish better sexual boundaries.

This program is also designed to help the non-offending parent be better aware of the indicators (i.e. specific behaviors) that maybe present with an individual suspected of inappropriate sexual behavior.

The program is designed in ten different sections, and at the end of each section there will be a test. Each participant is required to pass a test with a minimum score of 90% to move to the next section. At the end of the program there will be a final examination, where the participant is expected again to receive a minimum score of 90% for successful completion. Upon successful completion of the program, a **CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION** will be emailed directly to the address listed at the beginning of the program.

JUVENILE NON-OFFENDING PARENTING CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

This program is primarily designed for individuals (juveniles) who may have someone at home or in their family who have been accused of sexual abuse or has been adjudicated/convicted of a sexual offense. It was designed to help educate the responsible parties (non-offending parties) and ensure the safety of the children in the family and in the community.

This course can also be used as an educational tool for those who have allegations of sexual abuse to better understand sexual abusive behaviors and to establish healthier sexual boundaries.

The program is designed in ten different sections, and at the end of each section there will be a test. Each participant is required to pass a test with a minimum score of 90% to move to the next section. At the end of the program there will be a final examination, where the participant is expected again to receive a minimum score of 90% for successful completion.

Upon successful completion of the program, a **CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION** will be emailed directly to the address listed at the beginning of the program.
